The Golf Shop, Driving Range, Range Café, first tee shack and locker rooms **are open**.

Golfers will check in for their tee time in the golf shop.

Highland Pacific Golf will ensure the health and safety of our HP Members, guests and our team members.

Please note the responsibilities of our HP Members, their guests and our team members when they are at the course:

General Health

- **Masks are required in all indoor areas** for staff and guests. **Masks are recommended at the driving range** until you are at your hitting bay.

- Please note the maximum allowable persons in each room before entering.
- If you have an underlying medical condition or if you or anyone in your household do not feel well please stay at home.
- Maintaining a physical distance of two meters away from others is recommended from the time you arrive until the time you leave the course.
- Hand washing, physical distance and Communicable Disease Prevention awareness signage will be clearly posted for guests and staff.
- Our management will screen all staff through our digital time clock tool each day to monitor their health.
- Our management will educate staff on effective hand washing techniques and physical distancing.

Range Café

Please note the current Range Café operations outline:

Range Cafe Hours:

Monday- Closed

Tuesday through Sunday- 11:00 a.m.-6:30 p.m.

Please note that food service on Tuesdays and Wednesday is limited to pre-made sandwiches and sundries. We will have an extremely limited menu Thursday through Sunday. Please be kind to our team members as we navigate the current hospitality labor crisis.

- The food kiosk and Café are open for food and beverage services.
Outside alcohol is strictly prohibited and players will be asked to leave the course immediately if they are seen consuming outside alcohol.
- Range Café patrons may sit in a party of six people, due to the space in our Café.
- Guests are asked not to move tables and chairs.

Golf

- It is recommended that players arrive no earlier than 1 hour before the scheduled tee time.
- Golfers may remove the flagstick if they feel comfortable.
- Due to high demand for tee times group play will be limited.
- Physical distancing between players in the golf shop, at the staging area and at the teeing areas are still recommended.
- We will allow one rider on power carts for a single rider fee. Power carts and pull carts are available on a first come, first served basis. All carts will be cleaned and sanitized after each use to maximize the availability for golfers. Power cart fees are as follows:

Full Cart- \$42.00 plus tax

Single Rider Cart- \$30.00 plus tax

Shared Cart- \$21.00 plus tax

Please ask for our carts with dividers for maximum protection in a shared cart.
